APRAISE 2nd International Stakeholders Workshop



The 2nd APRAISE International Stakeholders Workshop "Improving Policy Makers' Knowledge Basis for Environmental Policy Making" is going to be implemented in the Center for European Policy Studies, on the 23rd of May 2014, in Brussels, Belgium. Main objective of the 2nd International Stakeholders Workshop is to discuss how policy makers' knowledge of environmental policy preparation and implementation can be improved by combining insights on policy effectiveness from

both model-based and empirical analysis. The Workshop is expected to:

- Provide better insights on possible co-effects of a policy and interactions between policy instruments,
- Support policy makers in selecting more effective environmental policy instrument mixes.

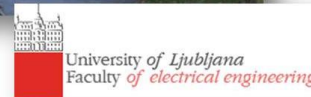

APRAISE Summer School

The APRAISE Summer School for postgraduate students is currently organized by the University of Ljubljana (UL), in cooperation with the rest of the APRAISE partners!

It is expected to take place in September, in the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, while its expected duration will be one week.



The Summer School implementation will enable students to meet, exchange experiences and ideas and to get new knowledge on different topics from the APRAISE curriculum. Its main objective is to teach students regarding the ways that policy making assists towards the establishment of a better environment. Students will be trained in:

- Using tools for policy analysis (market mapping, policy cycle analysis, identifying and analysing policy context factors),
- Learn how case study analysis and modeling work can jointly produce a dataset to

inform policy makers about the efficacy of environmental policy instruments.
